Aquaculture Project Manager / Cambodia Based - Khmer Speaking

AquaBioTech Group is seeking a suitably qualified person with experience in aquaculture, to work with a rapidly growing team of scientists and engineers. The successful candidate will be involved in researching, planning, and coordinating aquaculture development projects based in Cambodia. The successful candidate will need to: have experience in aquaculture development and training of small-scale farmers, possess knowledge transfer abilities, has extensive experience in Development Cooperation and Project Management, as well as be able to liaise successfully with granting agencies, clients and partners.


Synopsis of position offered

A position within the **AquaBioTech Group** has arisen for a suitably qualified person to be employed as an Aquaculture Project Manager Khmer Speaking. The work to be undertaken will be based in Cambodia and the person will be leading and managing aquaculture development projects in the region whilst being based there.

The duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assuring proper administrative, technical, and financial management of projects;
- Identifying project strategies and assess, planning, implementing, monitoring and evaluating of aquaculture activities
- Providing in-country coordination and support for aquaculture development projects in Cambodia;
- Providing technical and logistical guidance to field-based development and research activities on aquaculture, and integrated systems of fish farming
- Serving as a facilitator and supporter of coordination and communications regarding aquaculture development projects in Cambodia, liaising with local partners, government agencies and other institutions.

Reporting directly to the Business Development Directors the position is demanding, requiring a person who is highly motivated and self-organised. The selected person must be prepared to work to very tight deadlines in isolated and multi-functional projects and in conjunction with a team of international staff based at our head-office-in Malta, as well as staff who are working at the project sites.

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Qualifications Overview

The successful candidate is likely to have a solid background in Aquaculture, preferably with a M.Sc. level of education in Aquaculture / National Resource Management / Agriculture or in an equivalent educative profile relevant to the assignment. He or she will need to have at least 5 years of experience in the international consultancy sector, with at least 3 years of experience in aquaculture development, training of small-scale farmers and knowledge transfer, at least 2 years of management experience as a project manager and 3 years of experience in Development Cooperation projects. The national expert is also likely to have 6 months of regional aquaculture experience beyond their home country.

The selected candidate will have to speak and write English fluently as well as be proficient in both written and spoken Khmer. Knowledge of any other languages would be considered an asset, although not essential. The selected candidate must have a clear passport with no travel restrictions, no legal convictions held at any time and be in possession of a clean driving licence.

Financial Package

The successful candidate will be offered a two year, fixed-term contract with the company. The starting package offered for this position will be structured largely upon the chosen candidate, reflecting the experience the candidate brings to the company.
