Quality Control and Assurance Manager

The three focus areas of the department are the quality assurance of all scientific work undertaken in the applied wet-labs for the development, testing and validation of fish nutrition and fish health products, the work undertaken in analytical laboratories, ranging from ecotoxicology to water quality testing, through to the QA and QC work for all products that are manufactured in the company's facilities .

SYNOPSIS OF POSITION OFFERED

A position within the **AquaBioTech Group** has arisen for a suitably qualified person to work as a Quality Assurance Manager on a variety of quality control tasks within the Group's diverse portfolio. These tasks may include, but are not limited to:

- Line management of QA Assistant

Reporting directly to the R&D Director, the position is demanding requiring a person who is highly motivated, methodical, detail-oriented and organised. They must possess diplomatic, analytic and communication skills as well as be prepared to work to very tight deadlines in isolated and multi-functional tasks, and in conjunction with a team of international staff.

Qualifications Overview

The successful candidate will have at least a BSc degree in biotechnology, biology, chemistry, or related scientific field, with preferably a M.Sc. in the aforementioned fields.

The selected candidate is likely to have previous experience in auditing in a Good Laboratory Practices (GLP) and/or Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) environment and experience in the planning, conducting and reporting of study and facility inspections.

The selected candidate will have to speak and write English fluently. Knowledge of any other languages would be considered an asset, although not essential.

The selected candidate must have a clear EU passport with no travel restrictions or legal convictions and be in possession of a clean driving licence.

Financial Package

The successful candidate will be offered a long-term, fixed-term contract with the company.
